



COVID-19 Declaration Form – Campus entry

Charterhouse Public School (CPS) is taking a highly precautionary approach to manage the spread of COVID-19, which is in line with the latest national and local health advice.

As part of this approach, we are ensuring that parents declare complete information about their wards and in the event of COVID-19 infection, the school will not take any responsibility. If you feel your ward is showing any COVID-19 symptoms, CPS urge to keep your ward at home and inform our admin.

If you want to send your ward to CPS, we ask you to confirm the following before he/she can enter the campus:

- That your ward has not travelled overseas within the last 14 days;
- That your ward is not showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 (fever; flu like symptoms such as coughing, sore throat or headaches; or have difficulty breathing);
- That your ward has not had close or casual contact* with a person who has been confirmed with COVID-19; and
- That your ward will follow the School's directions regarding hand hygiene while on campus, including sanitising his/her hands
- As a parent, you take full responsibility of your ward in the event of him/her tested positive for COVID-19 or virus spread in the campus. CPS shall not be hold responsible for any emotional, legal or monetary liabilities incurred. You will not make any complain or take legal action against CPS. The school will not be responsible for the spread of Covid-19 and your ward getting infected with it by other student(s) at CPS.
